














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
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OUR MISSION AND VISION





This year, we educated nearly 350 students on a daily basis in 18 of our ThinkCenters across 6 districts. Our approach has been to meaningfully engage with the underserved children in orphanages, rural-villages, slums...etc. and provide them with exposure and education with consistency that they are deprived of.

Our approach is holistic! We make education fun, engaging, meaningful and practical. We do not restrict ourselves to books, classrooms or study-centers, we bring a good mixture of experiments, sports, art & craft, culture, study tour, social work... etc. along.




The ThinkCenters continue to be our prime focus for the year, while we slowly shape up the Gurukul for the future. The prime objective of the ThinkCenters have been to reach the unreachable, connect them with caring, capable and committed members of our team (we call it a family), so the children could get access to best of the education.

We realize, this is a big task in hand. Therefore there is a need to onboard like-minded and varied-skilled people from across the globe to become a part of this journey and to shoulder responsibility of building the next generation. Over 100 volunteers with varying capacity have come forward, while around 30+ taking regular classes.

The ThinkCenters

In today's world, where information is available in abundance but often overwhelming and confusing, the ability to think critically is more important than ever. Our Thinking Class provides students with the tools they need to navigate this complex landscape.

We offer Thinking Classes in our ThinkCenters to help students develop critical thinking skills. The primary goal is to teach students to think deeply, analyze critically, and make sound judgments. These classes are often interdisciplinary and involve problem-solving exercises.



We have designed three kinds of ThinkCenters for specific age, grade & ability groups:


- 1. Chatashalee (Village ThinkCenter): For students up to grade V and ensure they gain required fundamental numeracy, literacy & social skills.

CLASSES COVERED: While most of the subjects were covered, greater emphasis is given to Math, English, Science, Geography along with science activities & tinkering.

PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS: Quarterly & annual assessments were conducted by mentors to ensure student progress and plan for the future sessions.

INTER-CENTER COMPETITION: Noticed tremendous encouragement & improvement among student through Quiz, Geography, Language & vedic-math competitions.

WORKSHOPS: Resource persons were called upon to conduct enriching workshops on Vedic-Math, Science, Mandala, Painting, Story telling, Origami...etc.

SPORTS EVENTS: Our Annual sports event at Deogarh district saw hoofing participation of 470 participants 170 students and 300+ villages on 19/Feb/2023.

CULTURAL EVENTS: Independence-day, Republic-day, Dance, Music, Diwali / Ganesh / Saraswati pooja event planning, organization & celebration.

SOCIAL CONTRIBUTION: Village cleaning, Plantation, Social awareness drama through Nukkad-Nataks on education & alcohol addiction, Freedom movement...etc.

STUDY TOUR: Explored culture, heritage, monuments, science-parks, museums...etc on a 5-nights and 3-days study tour starting 25/Feb-01/Mar to BBSR, Puri & Konark.

1. OTC - Online Thinking Class

In the last 200 years, since the beginning of the industrial era, education has been happening within the close physical proximity with emphasis on knowing than understanding, delivered by preachers who have hardly practiced their preaching. These have been the greatest limiting factors for education, primarily for children in remote areas. We decided to shift this and initiated OTC in 2020, during the Covid-19 pandemic.

The idea is simple:

- 1. Break the distance barrier and reach the underserved with the help of technology.
- 2. Connect them with highly qualified, skilled, and self-motivated people across the world who could provide quality 21st-century education to them.
- 3. Instill critical thinking through inquiry-based learning (Socratics method).



1. OTC - Online Thinking Class ...(cntd.)

The uniqueness of the OTC is that the volunteers from 10 different countries take daily classes across all the centers. These are highly qualified professionals, such as scientists, doctors, engineers, teachers, researchers...etc. Our local/offline mentors then ensure completion of the revision of the same along with the assigned daily activities.

80% OF REGULAR OTC STUDENTS HAVE SCORED ABOVE 55% IN THEIR ANNUAL SCHOOL EXAM









2. Chatashalee - Village ThinkCenter

EK AHSA's chatashalee model has been designed keeping younger children in mind to shape their minds in the formative age. Children in rural villages such as the ones we operate, do not attend schools regularly. The focus on education has been really poor. Most students in class 3 to 5 do not even know to read or write properly.

Chatashalee model was initiated last year based on the requests from the villagers. By the end of the year we had 5 centers in 5 different villages. Students reached the level of reading, writing, perform arithmetic operations, basic problem solving... etc. This motivated us to do more.

Our journey took us to more villages as villagers from Kailash and Jareikela requested us to open centers in their villages. This was very encouraging and we embarked... Our intervention involved village meetings, parents interaction, identification of local mentor, a place for children to study... etc.
